## Appendix 1. Altruism measure

Imagine yourself in a situation in which you can keep or give to another person, all or any portion of $\$ 10$. You may give money only in increments of $\$ 1$. For example, you can give $\$ 0$ and keep $\$ 10$, or give $\$ 2$ and keep $\$ 8$, or give $\$ 8$ and keep $\$ 2$. These are only hypothetical examples, and the decision of how much to give is entirely yours.
